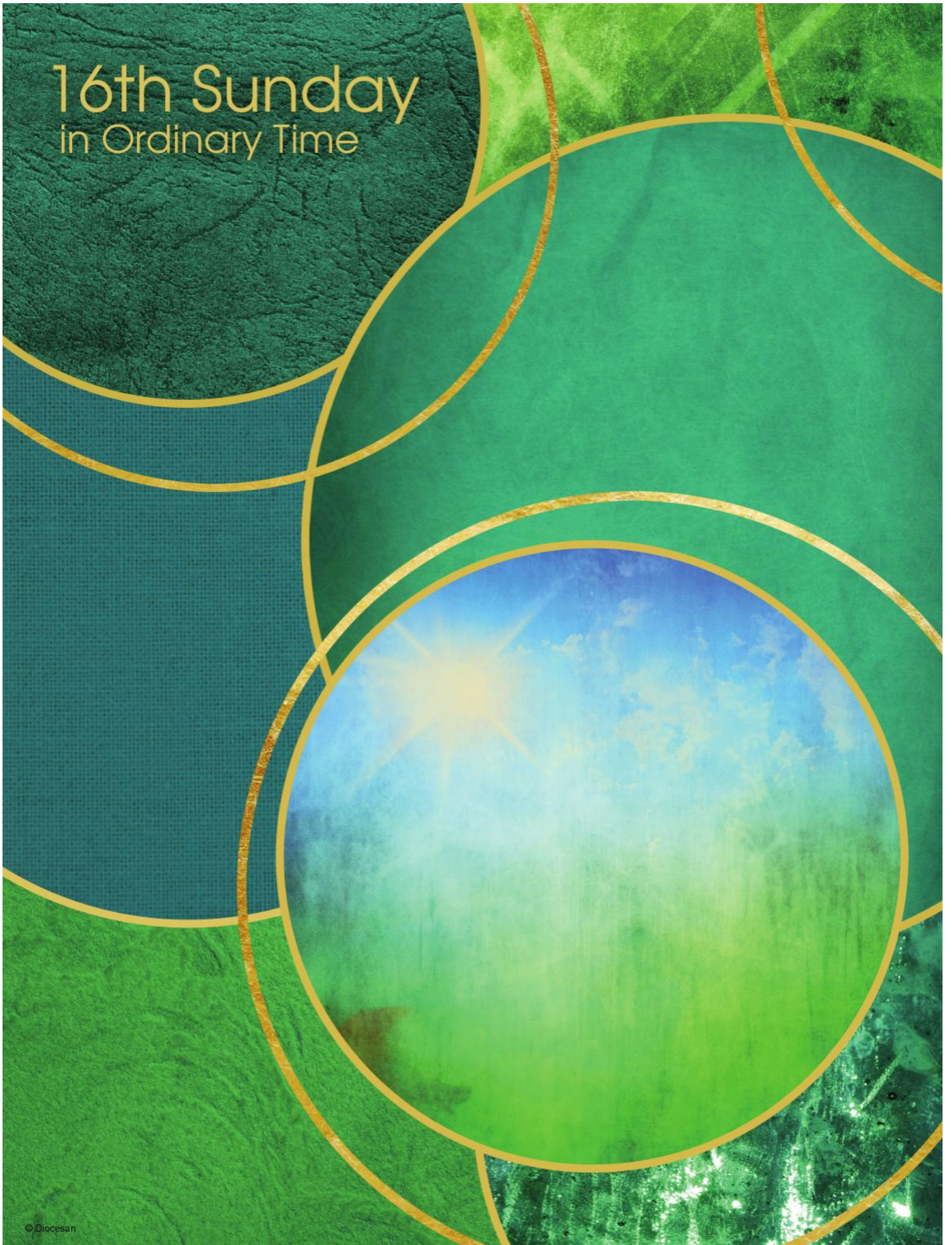


# 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

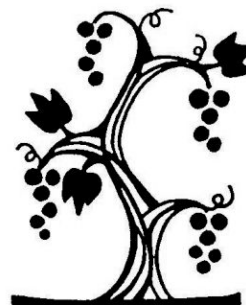
